## A4351 (Straight)

### Infyna Chic

Hydrophilic Intermittent Catheter

Infyna Chic catheters were designed with input from clinicians to help provide a high level of discretion for women who use catheters.

#### Discreet

- Discreet to carry with a unique combination of color, design, and small size
- Does not stain common fabrics\* if the contents are spilled
- Does not leak liquid when reclosed

#### Easy to Use

- Flip-top cap on packaging can be opened and closed with one hand
- Ready to use, prehydrated hydrophilic catheter
- Just right catheter stiffness helps support easy, touch-free insertion



\*Common fabrics include cotton, denim, and polyester.

#### Reimbursement

Intermittent catheters are covered to drain urine from the bladder for a patient who has permanent urinary retention. Permanent urinary retention is defined as when a patient is not expected to be medically or surgically cured within three months. For each catheter episode, Medicare will cover one catheter (A4351 or A4352) and an individual packet of lubricant (A4332).

Patients can get up to 200 intermittent catheters each month.

Onli catheters are designed for easy, every day use.

#### Easy to Use

- Easy to open packaging

- Sliding gripper (on 16" catheter) and funnel length help provide control

## A4352 (Coude)

### VaPro Coudé

No Touch Hydrophilic Intermittent Catheter

VaPro catheters provide 100% No Touch insertion with a protective tip and sleeve

#### Protective Tip

- Helps shield the sterile catheter during insertion from bacteria located in the first 15mm of the distal urethra
- Helps reduce the risk of carrying bacteria into the urinary tract

#### Protective Sleeve

- Allows the catheter to be gripped anywhere
- Provides a barrier to the catheter to help keep germs away

#### Coudé Tip

- Designed to help maneuver around tight bends found in a narrow urethra
- Suitable for males who have an enlarged prostate or similar condition



#### Reimbursement

A coude tip catheter for females is rarely needed and justified. When a coude tip catheter is prescribed, medical necessity must be documented in the medical record. An example would be the inability to catheterize with a straight-tip catheter.

### VaPro Plus Pocket

No Touch Hydrophilic Intermittent Catheter

#### Discretion

- Offered in pocket-size packaging for easy transportation and discreet out of home use

#### Collection Bag

- No toilet or receptacle is needed with the integrated collection bag of VaPro Plus Pocket Catheter
- Easy to open and easy to empty collection bag for cleaner handling



#### Reimbursement

Intermittent catheterization using a sterile intermittent catheter kit (A4353) is covered when the patient requires catheterization and meets one of the following criteria:

- Lives in a nursing facility
- Is immunosuppressed
- Has vesico-ureteral reflux
- Is a pregnant, spinal-cord injured female with neurogenic bladder
- Has had two or more urinary tract infections (UTI) during a 12-month period while using sterile intermittent catheterization with A4351/A4352 and sterile lubricant (A4332).
  - A UTI is defined by Medicare as when a patient has a urine culture with greater than 10,000 colony-forming units of a urinary pathogen and concurrent presence of one or more of the signs, symptoms, or laboratory findings as listed in the policy articles.
